## Universitas Negeri Malang Journal's Quest for Global Impact 2027

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On January 3, 2024, a meeting was held to evaluate the UM-Elsevier (Scopus) collaboration program for the international indexation of Universitas Negeri Malang's (UM) journals. The collaboration between UM and Digital Common in the management and editorial process of UM journals was initiated in the middle of 2023. UM opted to use the DC platform to improve the readability and performance of journal articles in the international community.

Based on the meeting results, nine journals were selected for international indexation. Two of these journals will be accompanied by Elsevier (Scopus) consultants, while the remaining seven will be migrated to the Digital Common (Citeus) page. These journals include Jurnal Kajian Bimbingan dan Konseling (JKBK); Bahasa dan Seni: Jurnal Bahasa, Sastra, Seni, dan Pengajarannya (JBS); Jurnal Pendidikan Geografi (JPG); Jurnal Praksis dan Dedikasi Sosial (JPDS); Buletin Konseling Inovatif (Buseli); Bulletin of Culinary Art and Hospitality (Bocah); Knowledge Engineering and Data Science (KEDS); Journal of Chinese Language and Culture Studies; and International Journal of Insight for Mathematics Teaching (Ijoimt).

The first journal accompanied by the Elsevier consultants is Jurnal Kajian Bimbingan dan Konseling (JKBK), a journal that publishes articles on guidance and counseling within an educational context. Currently, JKBK has been accredited at level 2 nationally and is also indexed in DOAJ (Directory of Open Access Journals) and Copernicus. The migration of Jurnal Kajian Bimbingan dan Konseling is led by Eko Pramudya Laksana. With years of service at Universitas Negeri Malang since 2015, Eko Pramudya Laksana has demonstrated a high level of dedication to the development of academic journals. The following journal is *Bulletin Konseling Inovatif (BUSELI)* journal or *Bulletin of Innovative Counseling* that features articles spanning guidance and counseling, special education, multicultural studies, trauma healing, mental health studies, clinical psychology, and career development within educational environments. It was established in 2021 and directly accredited by SINTA ranked 3. From its inception, the BUSELI journal has already attracted writers from abroad, signaling its readiness for internationalization. This achievement underscores BUSELI's preparedness to undergo the process of journal internationalization. In this context, the role of an expert who has a suitable and professional background becomes pivotal in guiding the steps toward this internationalization. The migration of *Bulletin of Culinary Art and Hospitality* into Citeus platform will be performed by Lisa Ramadhani Harianti. *Bulletin of Culinary Art and Hospitality* publishes articles on practice, theory, and

research in culinary art and hospitality. This journal was the journal established as a pilot international journal in UM.
